4 Make a *Friendship Bracelet*.

You need

- different colors of string
- tape

Instructions

1. Cut the string into 60-cm pieces.
2. Line up six pieces and fold them in half.
3. Tie each piece to create a 1-cm loop on one end.
4. Tape the looped end to your table.

5. Separate the pieces into three sections and braid them until you have a braid that can go around your friend's wrist.
6. Make a knot at the end of the braid. Leave 2 cm unbraided and cut off the rest of the string.
7. Put the bracelet around your friend's wrist.
