DIAGNOSTIC TEST

These tests check learner levels in relation to general standards. They provide a broad picture of knowledge and ability. In English language learning, examples are the TOEFL and IELTS exams, which are mandatory for foreign-language speakers seeking admission to English-speaking universities.

PLACEMENT TESTS

These tests only contain items which the students have been taught in class. They can be formulated as presentations, posters, assignments, or research projects.

PROGRESS TEST

These tests are used to measure how much you know and what you know. They can help a teacher know what needs to be reviewed or reinforced in class. They also enable the student to identify areas of weakness.

PROFICIENCY TEST

These tests are used to check a student's language level through grammar, vocabulary, reading comprehension, writing, and speaking questions. After establishing the student's level, the student is placed in the appropriate class to suit his/her needs.

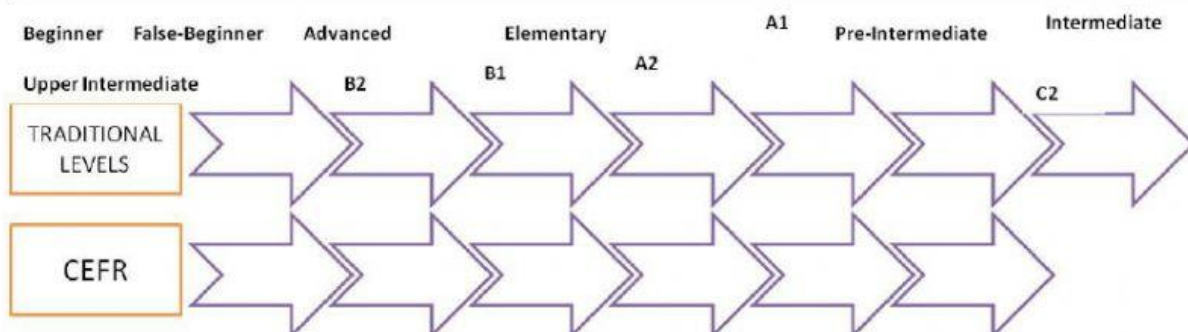
