
How to make a frozen pie crust look (and taste) homemade

Ingredients:

- 2 pie crusts
- 2 pie crusts
- Milk or half and half
- Bit of sugar
- Bit of cinnamon

Procedure:

1. Throw the pie crusts.
2. Place pie crusts into the crust. Fruit pies, such as apple, work best.
3. Put in a generous amount of the filling so it rounds up in the center.
4. Carefully turn the second pie crust on top of the filling.
5. Put it down lightly—it will look kind of messy, but that's OK.
6. Place the pie crusts on your usual homemade crust, or just cover the crust with a pie crust.
7. Cut some holes into the top.
8. Throw on sugar and cinnamon.
9. Sprinkle on sugar and cinnamon.
10. Bake for 45 minutes or until golden brown.
