Most of adjectives end in
-est.

Old = the oldest
Small = the smallest

Adjectives ending in **-e**

Large = the largest
Nice = the nicest

Adjectives ending in **-y**

Happy = the happiest
Lazy = the laziest

Adjectives ending with **one**
vowel + one consonant

Fat = the fattest
Hot = the hottest

Good = the best

Bad = the worst

Adjectives with **two** or
more syllables.

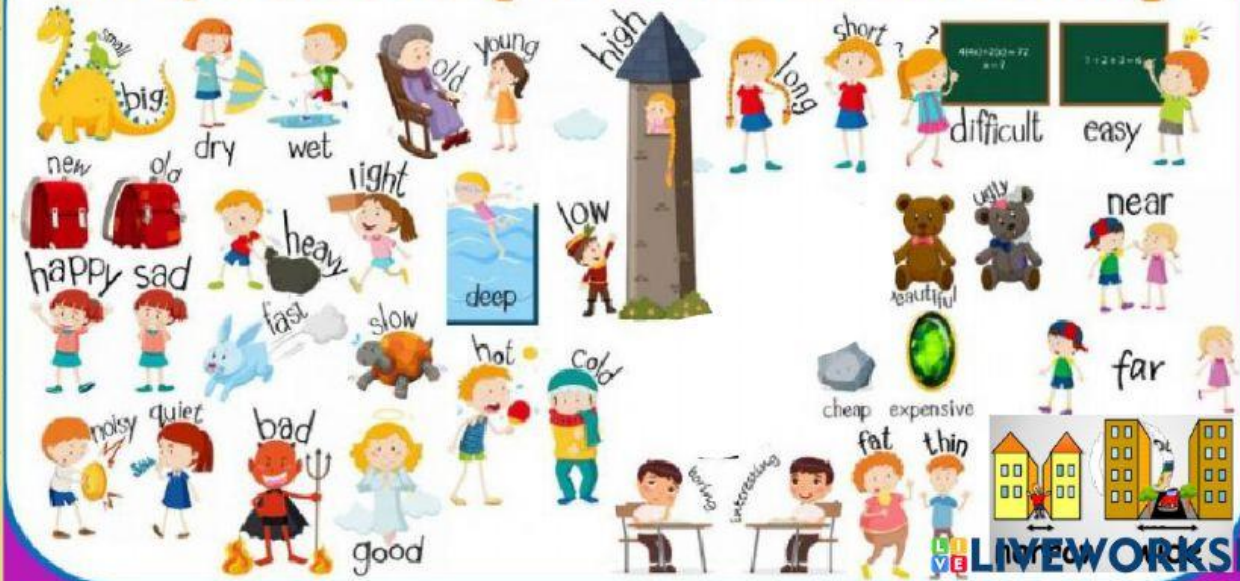
Dangerous = the most dangerous
