Eleuthera: The Island of Freedom

The island of Eleuthera, which was called **Cigateo**, is located east of the island of New Providence. The name Eleuthera is a **Greek** word that means **freedom**.

The first group of people that settled in Eleuthera were the Europeans who later called themselves the **Eleutheran Adventurers**. They were from the island of Bermuda. They came in search of religious freedom. Their leader was **Captain William Sayle**. On their journey to Eleuthera, the Eleutheran Adventurers were **shipwrecked**. They made it to land and they found a cave, which is now called Preacher's Cave.

The capital of Eleuthera is **Governors Harbour**. Eleuthera is famous for many things, one of them being the **Glass Window Bridge**.

Off of the coast of Eleuthera, there are three other inhabited islands. These are Current Island, Harbour Island and Spanish Wells. You can only get to these islands by ferryboat.

Harbour island is known for its pink sand beaches. Spanish Wells is famous for its multi-million dollar fishing industry.

The island of Eleuthera is **long** and **narrow**. It is also famous for its delicious **pineapples**. Pineapples grow in light red soil and they take eighteen months to grow. Every year in the month of **July**, the **Pineapple Festival** is held on the island of Eleuthera.
