

## ***Causative "make" to show force and obligation***

*Causative "make" has the same form as "have"*

*Example:*

He **made** her **clean** the whole house.

Look what you **made** me **do**.

*Causative "let" has the same form as "have"*

*Example:*

His parents **lets** him **party** until midnight.

If you love me **let** me **go**
