Directions: Read each passage and then pick the claim the author is making.

Passage #1

People often complain about the amount of trash on our ocean beaches, but I rarely hear anyone offering a solution. Let's face it—most of us are pretty lazy and do not want to have to walk very far to dispose of trash.

Those who run our state parks and recreation areas should recognize that. Installing more trash cans along our public beaches is the way to keep trash from being dumped on the sand.
