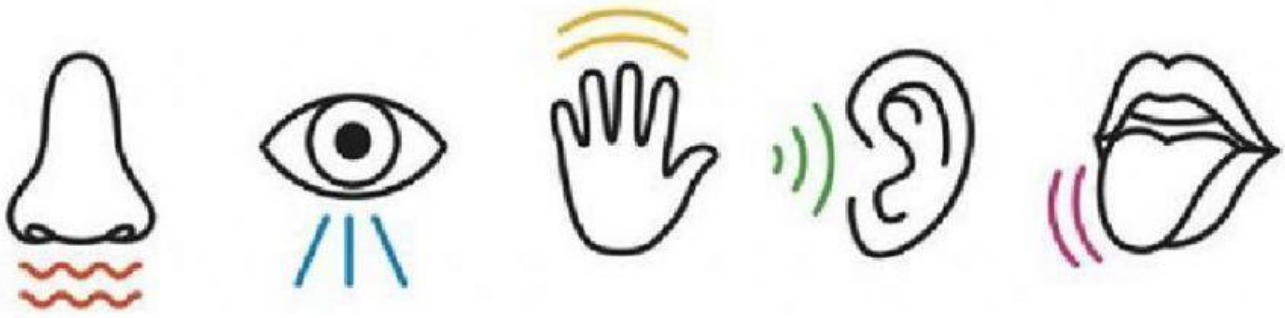


THE FIVE SENSES

The verbs *look*, *sound*, *feel*, *smell* and *taste* relate to our five senses: sight, sound, touch, smell and taste. We use *like* after these verbs when we compare something to something else.
