Remember the past tense is used to show action that has already happened.

Usually, **ed** or **d** is added to a verb to form the past tense. **eg.** walk – walked

If a verb ends with a consonant + y, change y to l and add ed **eg.** carry- carried

If a verb has a short vowel with one consonant, **double the consonant** and add ed.

**eg.** hop- hopped
