

Sometimes, your immune system fights against particles like dust or pollen. This fight against the environment can cause sneezing, runny nose and itchy eyes.



When germs get into the lungs, oxygen cannot get through. Pneumonia usually causes fever, cough and chest pain. When people get pneumonia, they have to go to hospital to be treated.




Influenza, or the flu, makes you sneeze and cough. You may get a fever, headaches and a runny nose. It is contagious, so it is important that you cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze.




Asthma is a lung disease that causes your airways narrow and swell. It causes recurring periods of wheezing (a whistling sound when you breathe), chest tightness, shortness of breath and coughing. Asthma medicine helps bronchial tubes return to their normal size.
