Erikson's theory on Psychosocial development

I. State the following statements as true or false.



1. During Stage 1, children develop the virtue **Hope** where they view the world as good, where people can be trusted.



2. During stage 2, children develop the virtue **Will** because the child is able to express his or herself by doing things on their own.



3. Erikson defined the virtue of stage 3 as **Purpose** because children take a step spontaneously by doing things on their own by setting goals for themselves.



4. Children between the age group of 9-12 years look back on their life and reflect whether they have lived a happy and productive life like older adults hence develop the virtue of **Competence**.



5. Children between the age group of 13-19 years, often experiment with different identities and viewpoints in order to find their true identity.



6. Erikson defined the virtue for Love because this stage involves finding **Love** in the various relationships one has (family and friends).



7. Generativity means generation because Erikson defined Generativity as giving back to the future generation by passing knowledge and skills, while also utilizing one's own skills.



8. At stage 8, Erikson defined the virtue as **Wisdom** because people depend on their family/children for their basic needs such as food, water, shelter and love.
