

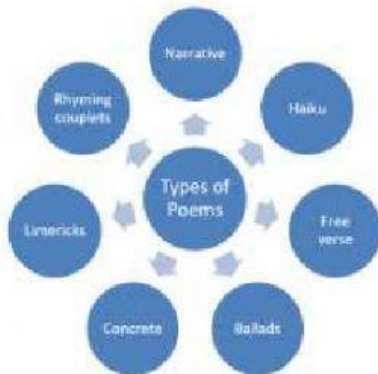

Diamante

A formula poem that is shaped like a diamond, and the words describes opposite ideas.

smile
happy, warm
welcoming, inspiring, soothing
curve, lips, expression, emotion
disturbing, deterring, depressing
sad, unwelcome
frown

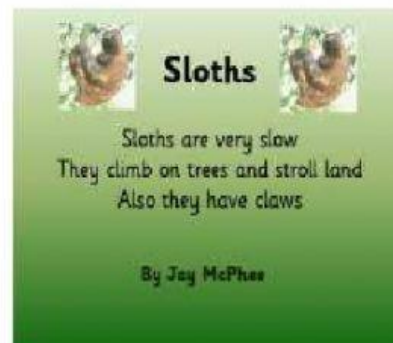
Limerick

A humorous formula poem that has five lines, an "AABBA" rhyming pattern, and a specific rhythm.

There was a young girl on a Tower..... **A**
Who looked just as fresh as a flower.... **A**
Her hair was like silk..... **B**
Her skin smooth as milk..... **B**
But her breath made the strongest knight cover..... **A**

Haiku

A Japanese poetic formula poem that has three lines and a total of 17 syllables, often distributed in specific 5-7-5 pattern.



Concrete



Acrostic

It is a poem in which the first letters of each line spell out a word or phrase.

Grandma is one special angel, a
Really gentle, beautiful soul.

Types of Stanzas

Clarification

A couplet is a two-line poem. The last word of each line rhymes.

example:

A baby spider played in the sun.
Bouncing on a web is so much fun.



Tercet

- A tercet is a poem, or stanza, written in three lines.
- Usually rhymes.
- Lines 1 and 2 can rhyme; lines 1 and 3 can rhyme; sometimes all 3 lines rhyme.



Winter Moon

How thin and sharp is the moon tonight!
How thin and sharp and ghostly white
Is the slim curved crook of the moon tonight!

Quatrain

- A quatrain is a poem, or stanza, written in four lines.
- The quatrain is the most common form of stanza used in poetry.
- Usually rhymes.
- Can be written in variety of rhyming patterns.
- (See slide 9 entitled "Rhyming Patterns.")

Word-Count Cinquain

- Word-count cinquain for younger students uses the following pattern:

Line 1: One word (title)
Line 2: Two words (describe the title)
Line 3: Three words (describe an action)
Line 4: Four words (describe a feeling)
Line 5: One word (another word for title)
