Conditional type 1 : If + present simple → will

Use: to predict the results of an action in the future.

Ex. If a supervolcano erupts, the climate will change.

Conditional type 2 : If + past simple → would

Use: to talk about things that are unreal or unlikely to happen in the future.

Ex. If Vesuvius erupted, people would be in danger.
