Conjunctions are words that join words or sentences.

These are **conjunctions**:

and or

The conjunction '**and**' is used to join words and sentences that have similar ideas.

The conjunction '**or**' is used to join words and sentences in order to show choice (often have question mark '?' at the end).

The shoe is yellow **and** white.
