A harbour	a garden with greenhouses for the culture, study and exhibition of special plants
A castle	a building where you can look at important objects connected with art, history, or science
A mosque	a place where people go to buy or sell things, often outside
A palace	a park with entertainments, such as games, machines to ride on, restaurants, etc, that are all based on one idea
Ruins	a structure that forces water up into the air as a decoration
A temple	a very tall, narrow building, or part of a building
A market	the largest and most important church in a particular area
A fountain	a building where people in some religions go to pray or worship
An aquarium	a large area containing several different pools, usually with equipment and activities for swimmers, that visitors pay to use
A museum	a large house where a king or queen lives
A national park	a model that looks like a person or animal, usually made from stone or metal
A tower	a large, strong building with towers and high walls, that was built in the past to protect the people inside from being attacked
A botanical garden	a building where fish and other water animals are kept for people to visit
A cathedral	a building where Muslims say their prayers
A theme park	a large area of park for use by the public, usually an area of special beauty
A statue	an area of water near the coast where ships are kept and are safe from the sea
A water park	the broken parts that are left from an old building or town
