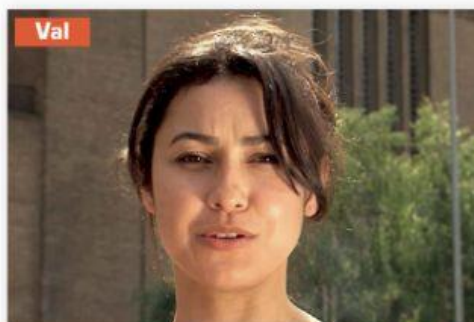


## UPPER INTERMEDIATE UNIT 9
