

Use *wish* + past form to imagine a different situation in the present.

Aya wishes we could eradicate poverty. She wishes the gap between rich and poor was / were smaller.

Use *wish* + past perfect to imagine the past.

Luis wishes everywhere hadn't gotten so polluted.

I'd forgotten that my friend's husband had lost his job. I really wish I **hadn't brought up / didn't bring up** the unemployment issue when we were having lunch last week.

I wish more people **would stop / stop** buying bottled water. It would go a long way toward protecting the environment.

I wish the government **could / will** eradicate poverty in our country.

My responsibilities at work include buying gifts for clients. I wish I **will have signed up / had signed up** for the green committee instead.
