The THREE parts of the nervous system are: brain spinal cord nerves

The job of the <u>brain</u> is to <u>receive information from various parts of the</u> body.

The spinal cord is located in the spine or backbone.

There are **THREE** main parts or sections of the brain.

The sections or parts of the brain are the cerebrum, cerebellum and medulla.

The function or job of the:

cerebrum- contains centers for the five senses, pain, memory, reasoning and speech.

cerebellum- controls muscles (muscular) coordination and balance.

medulla- controls vital life functions like your heartbeat, breathing, digestion, and blood pressure.
