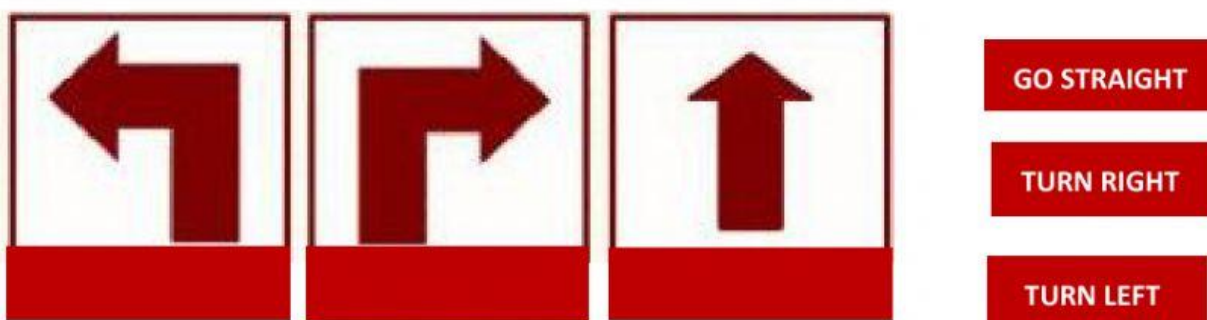

Tim: Sorry, do you know where is the?

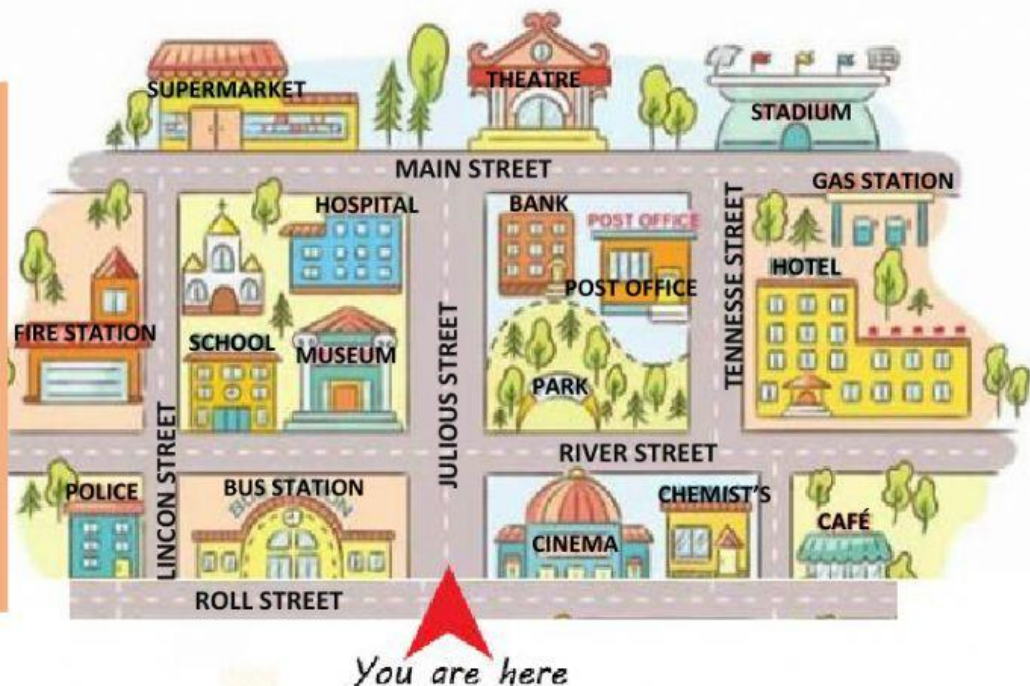
Man: Yes, of course. Go straight and turn right. Then go straight on and turn left. It's near the hotel.

Important!

Cuando pedimos indicaciones usamos expresiones como: "Excuse me (disculpe)"; "Sorry (perdon)."

Y preguntamos de la siguiente forma: "Do you know where is the? (Sabe dónde está el?)"

; "Where is the? (¿Dónde está el?)."

Cuando damos la información tenemos que:

- Usar expresiones como: "Yes, of course (Si, por supuesto)"; "Yes, sure (Si, claro)"
- Dar imperativos, es decir, ordenes. Por eso no usamos sujeto en la oración.

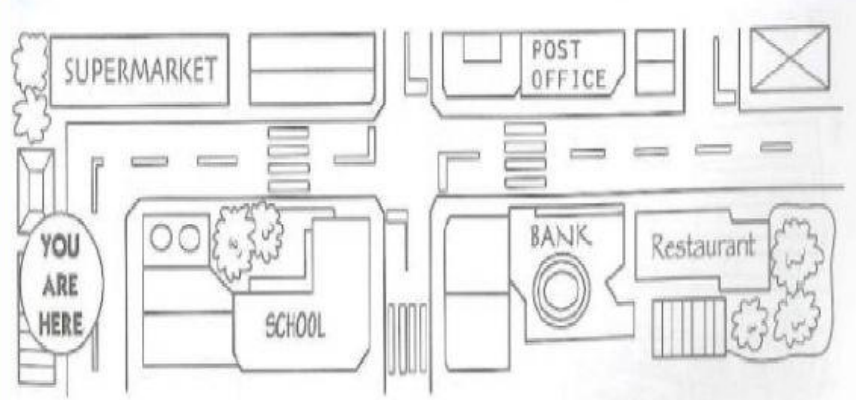

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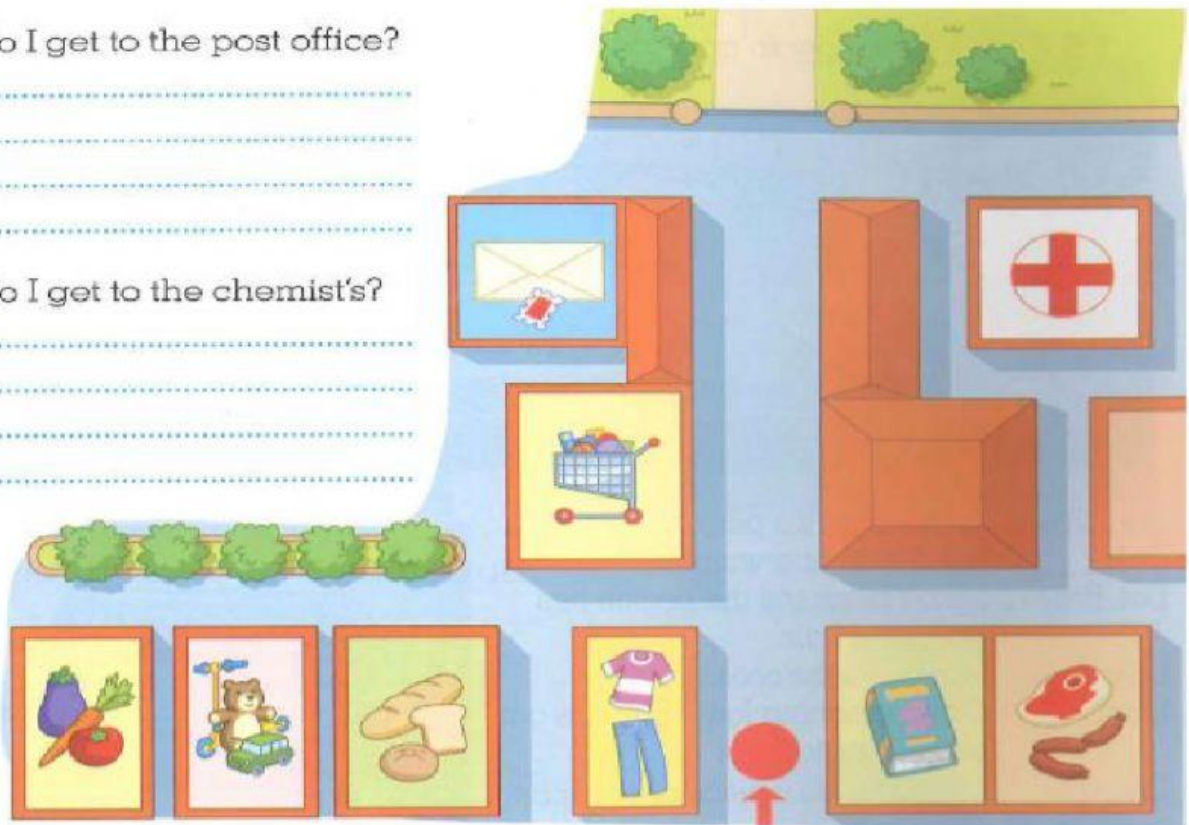
