**Look at the description and match it to the correct picture.**



**lollipop man**

This is a traffic light. It is placed in road intersections for safety of road users. When the light turns red, motorist must stop so pedestrians can cross the road.



**speed hump**

This is a pedestrian bridge. It is placed near busy areas. Pedestrians used this to cross safely to the other side of a dangerous road.



**traffic lights**

This is a no honking zone sign. It is placed in area near hospital or prayer building. Motorist are advised to show respect and not horn in this area.



**zebra crossing**

This is a lollipop man. He stops traffic by holding the 'stop' sign. He makes sure school children cross the road safely.



**pedestrian bridge**

This is a speed hump. It is found outside school areas. It prevents drivers from exceeding the speed limit of 30 kilometres per hour.



**no honking zone**

This is a zebra crossing. It is placed near school. When motorists see this, they slow down to let them cross the road safely.
