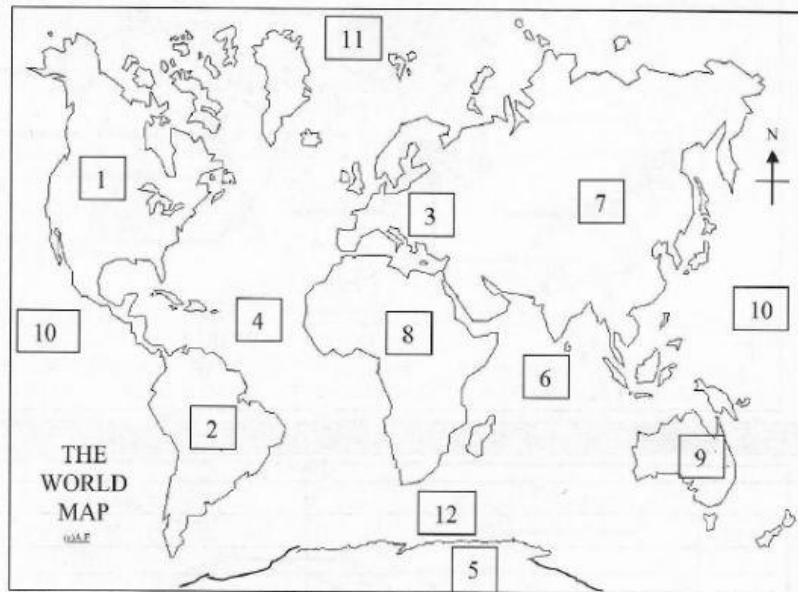


LET'S TRAVEL AROUND THE WORLD!
