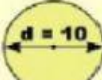

Naming circles, diameters, and radii

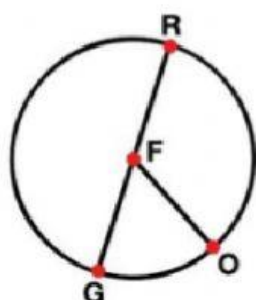
Circles

A **circle** is named by the point in the center.

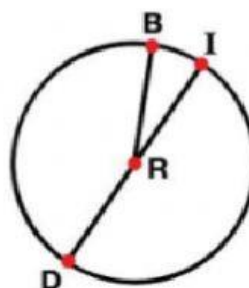
A **radius** is a line segment from the center of the circle to the edge.

A **diameter** is a line segment that passes through the center of a circle. It has two points on the outside edge of the circle.

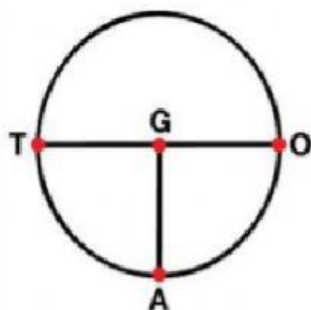
