

Vocabulary about gender violence

Heteropatriarchy	the use of physical force to harm someone because of their gender identity
Gender violence	an invisible barrier within a hierarchy that prevents women or minorities from obtaining advanced positions
Glass ceiling	an exaggerated sense of power or strength or masculine pride
Purplewashing	the belief that men and women should have equal rights and opportunities
Vicarious violence	It is used to describe a variety of political and marketing strategies promoted by countries, people, companies and other organizations to look like supporting gender equality
Sexism	social system in which men and heterosexual people define what is or isn't normal in gender terms
Feminism	type of violence which intends to harm women by hurting children and the rest of the family
