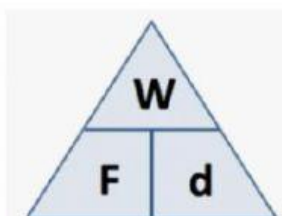

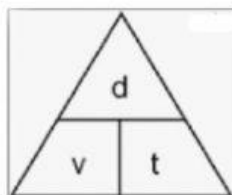

FORMULAS



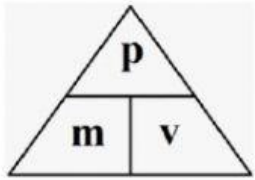
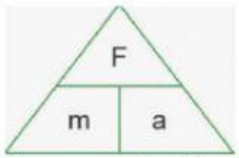
force times distance $w=Fd$



distance divided by time
 $s=d/t$

$$KE = \frac{1}{2}mv^2$$

one half of mass times velocity squared

 mass times velocity $p=m*v$	 mass times acceleration $F=ma$	$a = \frac{v_f - v_i}{t}$ final velocity minus initial velocity divided by time
 mass times gravity $F_g=m*g$ ($g=9.8$)	$E_p = mgh$ E_p = Potential Energy m = Mass g = Gravitational Field Strength h = Vertical Height mass times gravity times height $GPE = m*g*h$	ONE of these formulas is used 2x

UNITS

units are newtons (N)	units are meters per second (m/s)	units are kilograms times meters per second ($kg*m/s$)
units are joules (J)	units are meters per second squared (m/s^2)	certain units are duplicated
