

## PAST SIMPLE AND PAST CONTINUOUS

### FORM

PAST SIMPLE	PAST CONTINUOUS
<b>FORM:</b> I/ you /he/ she / we / they/ work <u>ed</u> * (regular verbs) <b>went</b> (irregular verbs)  I/you/he/she/we/they <b>didn't work</b> <b>didn't go</b>  <b>Did</b> I/you/he/she/we/they <b>work/go</b> ?	<b>FORM:</b> Subject + was/were + ---ing  I / he / she / it <b>was going</b> home We / you / they <b>were going</b> home  I / he / she / it <b>wasn't working</b> We / you / they <b>weren't working</b>  Where <b>was</b> I/ he / she / it <b>going</b> ? Where <b>were</b> you / we / they <b>going</b> ?
