PAST SIMPLE	PAST CONTINUOUS
<p>FORM:</p> <p>I / you / he / she / we / they / worked* (regular verbs) went (irregular verbs)</p> <p>I / you / he / she / we / they didn't work didn't go</p> <p>Did I / you / he / she / we / they work / go?</p>	<p>FORM: Subject + was/were + ---ing</p> <p>I / he / she / it was going home We / you / they were going home</p> <p>I / he / she / it wasn't working We / you / they weren't working</p> <p>Where was I / he / she / it going? Where were you / we / they going?</p>
