There are 24 different kinds of rattlesnake and each **kind** looks different, some are green, others are brown or black. Some kinds of rattlesnake live in the Sonoran Desert in North America, but other kinds live on mountains and in **forests**. Rattlesnakes have a poisonous bite, which they use to **quickly** kill the small animals they eat, such as mice, **rabbits**, lizards and frogs. All rattlesnakes have a rattle at the **end** of their tail, and they shake it to tell other animals to not come near.
