REMEMBER

Some & any

some and **any** mean 'an indefinite number or amount'

plural countable



uncountable nouns



SOME

We bought **some** flowers.
He's having **some** rice today.

ANY

We didn't buy **any** flowers.
He's lazy. He never cooks **any** rice.



WE USE **SOME** IN AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES.

WE USE **ANY** IN QUESTIONS AND NEGATIVE SENTENCES.
