**→ Did + S + use to + Vo?**

Ex: Did you use to smoke cigarette?

**3. Be / get used to + V-ing / noun. (phrase) (quen)**

= **Be / get accustomed to + V-ing / noun (phrase). (quen)**

Ex: I am used to living in HCMC.
