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Adjectives with one syllable, add: '-er' or '-r' + 'than'	<b>cold</b> "In Canada, winter is <u>colder than</u> summer."
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Adjectives with two or more syllables, add: 'more' + 'than'	<b>ex-pen-sive</b> "This book is <u>more expensive than</u> that book."
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Adjectives that end in a single vowel and consonant: double the final letter before adding 'than'	<b>big</b> "Russia is <u>bigger than</u> Canada."	Adjectives with two syllables that end in '-y', change '-y' to 'i' and add: '-er' + 'than'	<b>hap-py</b> "John is <u>happier than</u> David."
