(If clause)

would + V1 (inf)

(main clause)

If + S + V2

S + would + V1 (inf)

Ex. If you **asked** your mom , she **would help** you.

His father **wouldn't be** angry if he **didn't tell** the lie.

If I **were** you, I **would take** the offer.
