

ADJECTIVES

Adjectives are words that describe a noun or a pronoun. They remain the same for singular and plural nouns or pronouns.

Ex. A rabbit is a small animal.

Rabbits are small animals.

Three types of adjectives.

1. Adjectives of quality tell us the quality of nouns.

Eg: Meera is a good girl.

I have a beautiful doll.

2. Adjectives of quantity tell us the quantity or number of nouns that are not exact or specific.

Eg: Radha needs some water.

Many people attended the meeting.

3. Adjectives of number tell us the exact number of nouns or their order or position.

Eg: They bought two chocolates.

Neeraj won the first prize.
