

Find eight differences between your fridge and your partner's fridge.

Ask questions: "How much ...?" and "How many ...?"

Example: How many eggs have you got in your fridge? How much milk have you got in your fridge?

Find EIGHT differences between your fridge and your partner's fridge.

Student A's fridge

3 tomatoes	4 bananas
4 carrots	$\frac{1}{2}$ kilo meat
100g cheese	250g butter
2 oranges	2 lettuces
1 litre milk	$\frac{1}{2}$ litre cream
2 litres orange juice	3 yoghurts

Find EIGHT differences between your fridge and your partner's fridge.

Student B's fridge

E.g.

A How many eggs have you got in your fridge?

B I've got six eggs in my fridge.

A I've got twelve eggs. That's one difference!
