

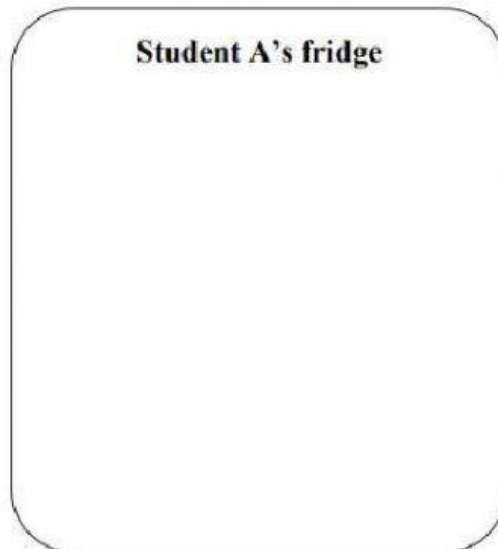
Find eight differences between your fridge and your partner's fridge.

Student A's fridge



Find EIGHT differences between your fridge and your partner's fridge.

Student B's fridge

5 tomatoes	4 apples
4 carrots	1 ½ kilo meat
200g cheese	150g butter
2 oranges	3 lemons
2 litres milk	½ litre cream
2 litres apple juice	6 yoghurts

E.g.

A How many eggs have you got in your fridge?

B I've got six eggs in my fridge.

A I've got twelve eggs. That's one difference!
