FOOD


Families start storing food in special bins or even in pits. This becomes a big progress because this way they can conserve food for food shortage.

Neolithic humans start grinding cereal into flour to make elaborated food, as bread.



TOOLS

Neolithic humans invent the loom, which Neolithic people use to weave clothes. From that moment on, clothes are more elaborated and they are more durable as well.


Thanks to the loom, they also manage to make first sails, which help them to navigate the seas.


