Vocabulary Words

Archipelago: a large group or chain of islands and cays.


Bluffs: A high land mass that is apart of the land, but juts into the sea.

Sounds: A sound is a narrow body of shallow water connecting a mainland and an island.

Salinas: a narrow body of deep water between a mainland and an island.

Creeks: a narrow body of water that run inland from the ocean.

Flats: an area of shallow, muddy water, usually around mangroves.
