7. I'll consider that although both roads have been worn about the same.



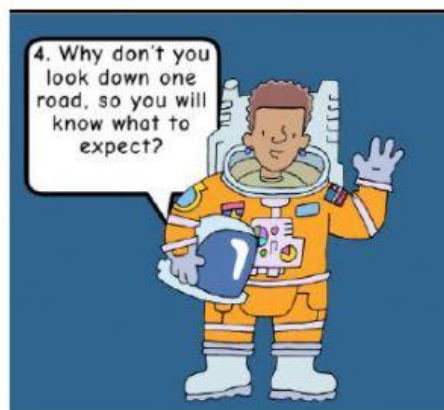
