-d	-ed	-ed double consonant	-ied
live	cook	stop+p+ed	study = study + ied
↓	↓	↓	↓
lived	cooked	stopped	studied
↓	↓	↓	↓
verbs that ends in -e	verbs ends in vowel + consonant	verbs ends in consonant + y	X
-n, -l, -p			play = played

teach	taught
have	had
tell	told
get	got
build	built
write	wrote
