

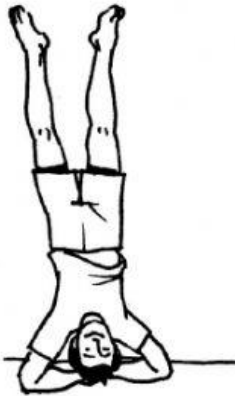


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REFLEXIVE PRONOUNS

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- 1 Reflexive pronouns show that the **action** of the verb **returns to the doer**.
- 2 Reflexive pronouns are 'myself', 'yourself', 'himself', 'herself', 'itself', 'yourselves', 'themselves' and 'ourselves'.
- 3 'Myself', 'yourself', 'himself', 'herself', 'yourselves', 'themselves' and 'ourselves' are used for **people**.
- 4 'Itself' and 'themselves' are used for **animals**.

He can do headstands by **himself**.
She can button her shirt by **herself**.
You must clean up the mess **yourselves**.
They can bathe the dog by **themselves**.
We are enjoying **ourselves** at the party.
Be careful! Don't cut **yourself**.
The dog is eating by **itself**.

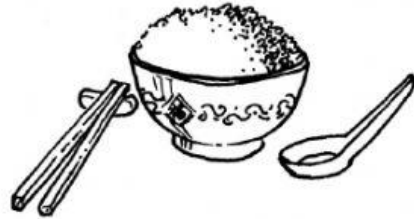

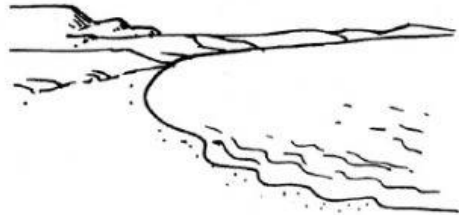
