## Regular/Irregular Plural Noun

Add **-s** at the end of most nouns to make the plural.

Car → cars

For nouns ending in **s, x, z, ch** or **sh**, add **-es** at the end.

church - church**es**

fox → fox**es**

sash → sash**es**

To form the plural nouns of words that end in a consonant and **y**, change the **y** to **i** and add **-es**

ferry → ferries

If the noun ends with a vowel + **y** just add '**s**'

boy → boys

To form the plural nouns of most words that end in **f** or **fe**, change the **f** or **fe** to **-ves**.

Knife → knives

Some singular nouns have special irregular plural forms.

child → children

Some nouns share the same singular and plural nouns forms

sheep → sheep
