TWICE, is a South Korean girl group formed by JYP Entertainment. The group is composed of nine members: Nayeon, Jeongyeon, Momo, Sana, Jihyo, Mina, Dahyun, Chaeyoung, and Tzuyu. Twice was formed under the television program Sixteen (1) _____ and debuted on October 20, 2015, with the extended play (EP) *The Story Begins*.



When the (2) _____ of JYP Entertainment, Park Jinyoung, announced the label's new girl group, he explained that Twice's name refers to the act making an impact "(3) _____ through the ears and (4) _____ through the eyes." Quite fittingly, the group's rise to fame has been propelled by consecutive hits that have a vibrant sound

Seoul-based K-Pop girl group Twice features members from Korea, Japan, and Taiwan performing bright, (5) _____ pop tunes. The k-pop band rose to hall of (6) _____ in 2016. Within 19 months after debut, Twice had already sold over 1.2 million units of their four EPs and special album. Their debut Twicetagram topped the Korean, Taiwanese, and U.S. World charts upon (7) _____ in 2017. In 2020, they made their first appearance on the Billboard 200. Later, they bested that showing with their sophomore full-length, Eyes Wide Open.
