The Summary of *Charlotte's Web*

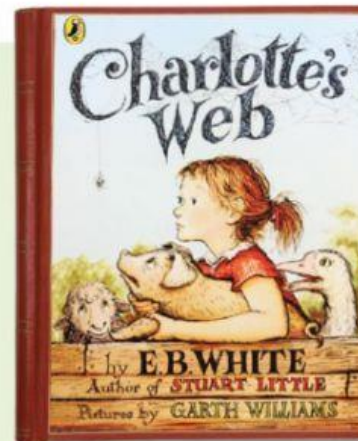
