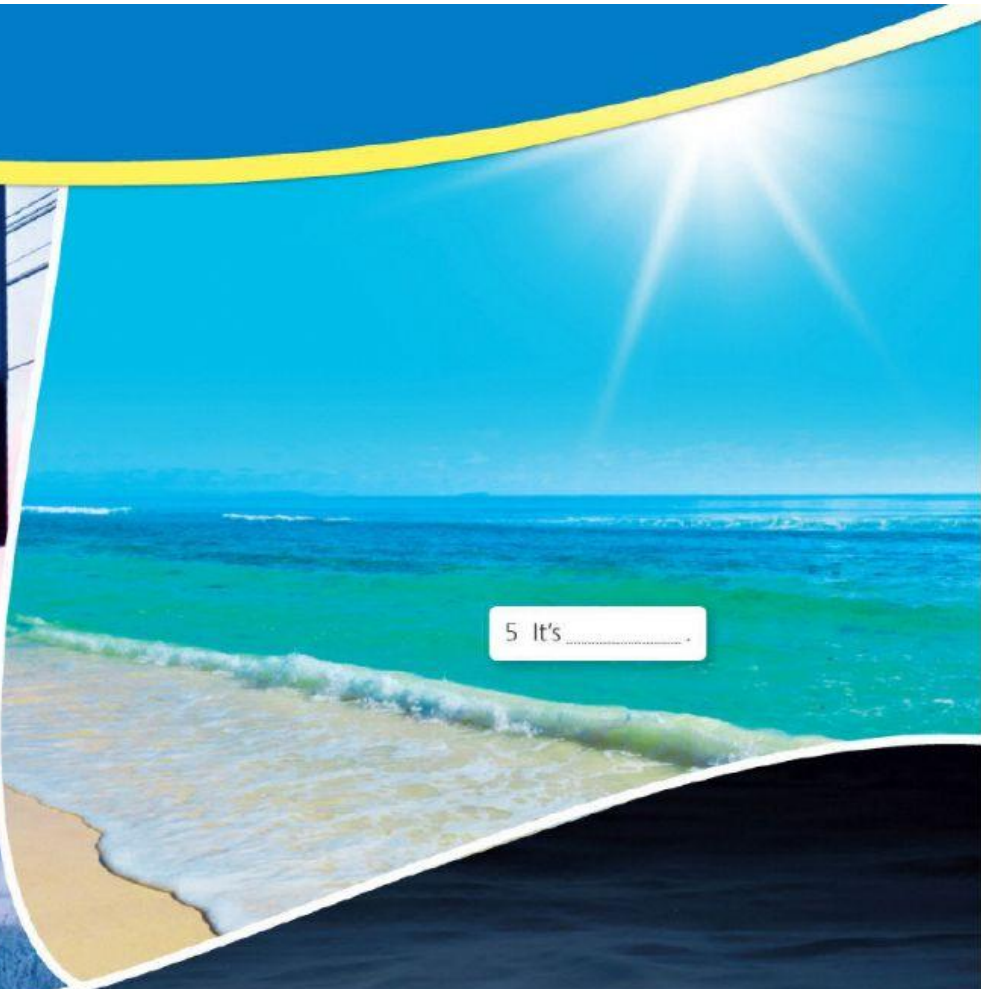

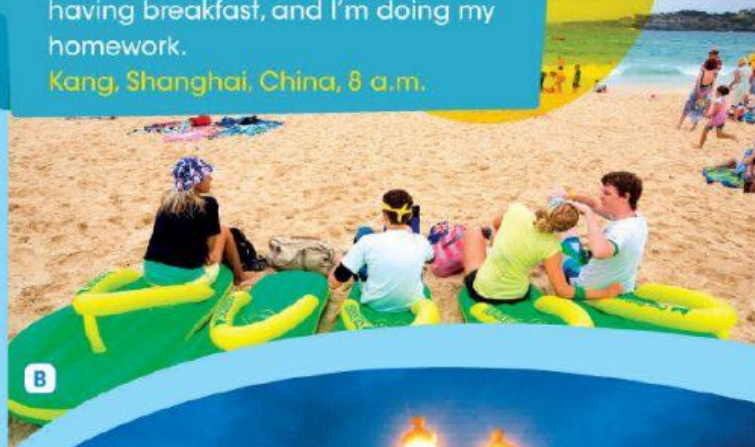

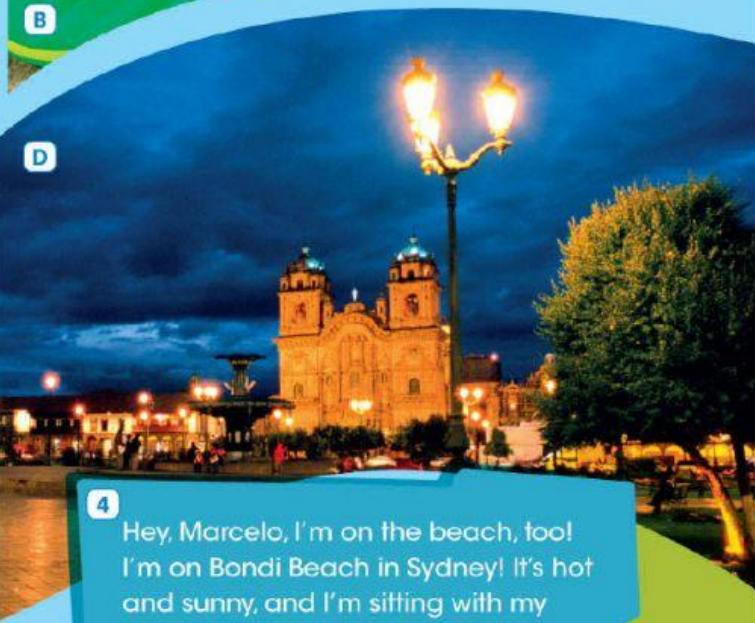

Take note!

Spelling rules for -ing forms

- Regular: add **-ing**
work → working
- Consonant + -e: e + **-ing**
dance → dancing
- One vowel and one consonant: double the consonant + **-ing**
sit → sitting
