<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Regular verbs form their past and past participle forms by adding -ed. <p>There are mainly rules of regular verbs</p> <p>Rule #1</p> <p>If a verb ends in <i>-e</i>, add <i>-d</i>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> like → liked arrive → arrived decide → decided <p>Rule #2</p> <p>If a verb ends in consonant + <i>-y</i>, change <i>-y</i> to <i>-i</i> and add <i>-ed</i>.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> carry → carried try → tried study → studied <p>Rule #3</p> <p>If a verb ends in vowel + <i>-y</i>, add <i>-ed</i>.*</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> play → played stay → stayed enjoy → enjoyed 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Irregular verbs form their past and past participle forms in different ways. <p>There are mainly three types of irregular verbs:</p> <p>Type # 1</p> <p>Verbs in which all the three forms are the same (e.g. put – put – put)</p> <p>Type # 2</p> <p>Verbs in which two of the three forms are the same (e.g. sit – sat – sat)</p> <p>Type # 3</p> <p>Verbs in which all three forms are different (e.g. drink – drank – drunk)</p>	

Rule #4

If a verb ends in a consonant-vowel-consonant (CVC) pattern, double the final consonant and add *-ed*.**

- **hug** → **hugged**
- **plan** → **planned**
- **stop** → **stopped**

Rule #5

For all other verbs, add *-ed*.

- **watch** → **watched**
- **ask** → **asked**
- **clean** → **cleaned**

Some verbs can be both regular and irregular.

Burn – **burnt** – **burnt** (irregular)
Burn – **burned** – **burned** (regular)

Dream – **dreamt** – **dreamt** (irregular)
Dream – **dreamed** – **dreamed** (regular)

Lean – **lent** – **lent** (irregular)
Lean – **leaned** – **leaned** (regular)

Learn – **learnt** – **learnt** (irregular)
Learn – **learned** – **learned** (regular)

Leap – **leapt** – **leapt** (irregular)
Leap – **leaped** – **leaped** (regular)

Smell – **smelt** – **smelt** (irregular)
Smell – **smelled** – **smelled** (regular)

Spill – **spilt** – **spilt** (irregular)
Spill – **spilled** – **spilled** (regular)

Spoil – **spoilt** – **spoilt** (irregular)
Spoil – **spoiled** – **spoiled** (regular)
