If you have two verbs for one subject the first verb is conjugated (with the correct form) the second verb stays in the infinitive (ar, er, ir –not conjugated)

A. The following verbs are often used with other verbs in the same sentence.

Querer = to want to do something

Verbs like gustar (aburrir, encantar, interesar etc.) **don't forget me, te, le, nos**

Tener + que+ verb = to have to do something

Tener + ganas de = verb = to feel like doing something

Pensar = to think

Necesitar = to need

Saber + verb = to know how to do something

Pensar + verb = to plan something

Empezar + verb = to begin to do something

Preferir + verb = to prefer to do something

Acabar de + verb = to have just done something

Hay que + verb = to have to do something (don't change "hay que")

Deber + verb = ought to do something (should)

Poder + verb = to be able to do something (can)

Gustar+verb= to like to do something (gusta/gustan)
