

Giving change

When you work out an amount of change, try counting on.

Example

What is the change from \$10 for a t-shirt costing \$8.20?

80c + \$1 = \$1.80 change
\$8.20 → \$9.00 → \$10.00

\$8.20 up to \$10 is \$1.80

Subtracting money

Fadi has \$95.49 in his savings. He spends \$79.63 on a radio. How much money does he have left?

Change them both to cents and then subtract:

$$\begin{array}{r} 89\cancel{5}^{14}\cancel{5}^{14}9 \\ - 7963 \\ \hline 1586 \end{array}$$

$$1586\text{¢} = \$15.86$$
