Mediterranean... The Best Weather!

There are some coastal regions on **earth** that are near the Mediterranean sea. The weather is mild and there are only two seasons: summer and winter. This **climate** is called Mediterranean.

It is usually warm, hot, and dry when it is summer. The winter **season** is **mild** or cool and it usually rains.

› **Landscape:** The Mediterranean landscape has rivers with an irregular flow, and they carry very little water.

The vegetation is made up of trees such as holm oaks and pine trees. Grape vines, fig trees, olive trees, and citrus trees also grow. There are also shrubs and aromatic plants such as lavender and rosemary.

› **Human Impact:** The human impact on the Mediterranean landscape is noticeable! Many forests are cut down to **plant** wheat, olive trees, and create pasture for livestock. Many inland and coastal **areas** are transformed to build hotels and resorts for tourism.
