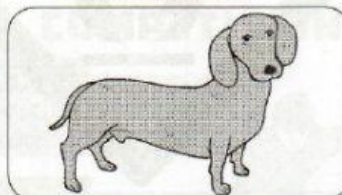

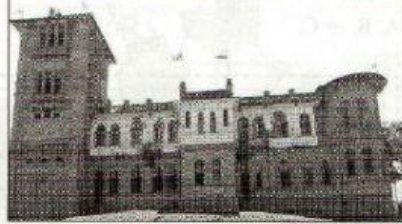

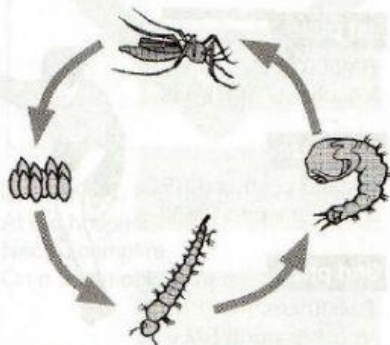

THE TURTLES OF WRECK ROCK BEACH

We have heard the arising reports regarding the endangered species. It is not an exemption for the sea turtles as well. Wreck Rock Beach may be a long way from anywhere but for hundreds of endangered sea turtles, it is their home. Same goes to veteran turtle monitors, Nev and Bev McLachan who comes there every summer since 1977.

Both Nev and Bev never take this role as an easy job. Sleep and turtle patrol are not bedfellows. This Sunshine Coast couple bounce along 22 km of starlit beach on quad bikes every night – often all night – during their annual eight-week vigil, looking for the loggerhead and green turtles that arrive on night tides to lay their eggs. They look for the first sign that is usually tyre-like flipper tracks between the shoreline and tussock dunes. The first loggerhead looks at first for sand dune or beach rock in the evening to start laying her eggs. The features of the massive reptilian tail and craggy parrot-like beak, the flippers jerking and breath hissing, she will follow a sandy depression (called 'body-pitting'), then dig a hole ('egg-chambering') to lay 100 ping-pong ball-sized eggs.

With expert ease, Nev notes the numbered metal tag on the front flipper and measures the shell length that is around 99.1 cm, a little above average. Other details that will be recorded are nesting time and place, species and other particulars that will be sent to a centralized database. Despite their far-flung location, Nev and Bev don't work in isolation. They're part of a long-term grassroots movement recording turtle activity at more than a dozen beaches along the Queensland coast and offshore islands. Bev says he loves going out and seeing the turtles and monitoring them but now he gets more enjoyment on looking at the databases.
