## 1. MATCH:

It takes place in the most elevated areas.  
Summers are cool (15C) and winters are cold, usually below 0C  
Abundant precipitation all year long. Snow in winter.  
Teide, Aneto, Mulhacen, Monte Perdido or Moncayo are some examples.

Subtropical

Typical climate from the interior of the peninsula.  
Temperatures are extreme: 45C difference easily!  
Precipitation is irregular and scarce. Autumn and Spring.  
Madrid, Zaragoza, León, Teruel, Toledo...

Mountain

Climate from the Canary Islands.  
Temperatures are regularly mild all year through. Around 20°C.  
Little precipitation, especially in the Southern Islands.  
There are no seasons as such.

Continental

Characteristic from the Mediterranean shore and a big part of Andalusia.  
Temperatures are soft because the sea is close.  
Scarce precipitation, especially in Alicante and Murcia.  
Gota Fría in summer: heavy rain in little time = floodings
