On April 12, 1961, aboard the spacecraft Vostok 1, Soviet cosmonaut **Yuri Gagarin** becomes the first human being to travel into space. During the flight, the 27-year-old test pilot and industrial technician also became the first man to orbit the planet, a feat accomplished by his space capsule in 89 minutes. Gagarin is best remembered by a generation of Russians for pronouncing "Poyekhali!" or "Let's Go!!" as his Vostok spacecraft lifted off the ground.



Valentina Tereshkova, Soviet cosmonaut, the first woman to travel into space. On June 16, 1963, she was launched in the spacecraft Vostok 6, which completed 48 orbits in 71 hours. In space at the same time was Valery F. Bykovsky, who had been launched two days earlier in Vostok 5; both landed on June 19.
